This group of people is called the creative team. See the next page to learn about these jobs and what they do for the show!

What does the Creative Team do?

Director - This is the person who made the story into the show you are seeing and helped the actors understand what to do on stage.

Scenic Designer - This is the person who imagined what the set would look like and how to build and paint it. The backdrop and large items you see were painted by some of our cast members. Can you guess which ones?

Costume Designer - This is the person who imagined what the costumes would look like and created many of them from patterns and fabric. For this show, many of these costumes were designed for our first version of *Mother Goose on the Loose* 20 years ago, and some of those 20 year old costumes are still on stage today. Can you guess which ones?

Light Designer - This person imagined what the lighting would look like on stage and where to hang all the lights you see above the stage. They make sure you only see what they want you to see.

Sound Designer - This person found all the music and sound effects for the show. This person is also an actor in the show. Can you find which character they play?

Make-up Designer - This person figured out how the faces of the characters, especially the animal characters, will look on stage. Our make-up designer is also a very prominent character in the show. Can you guess which one?

Choreographer - These people set very specific moves for the actors for a fight scene or a dance scene. They are responsible to make sure the actors are safe and specific with their movements. There is one big fight scene and some smaller ones. Can you spot them? Remember, these actors had special training, so don't try their fight moves at home.

Stage Manager - This person makes sure that the actors and technicians know when to do what they are supposed to do and makes sure everyone shows up for rehearsals and shows.




