

## DIRECTOR'S NOTE

The wardrobe. A passageway to another world. Just the act of writing those lines warms my heart and stirs my imagination. To be transported to another world, is at the core of so many childhood dreams and fantasies. Oz, Middle-earth, Hogwarts...they all capture a sense of magic and wonder and there is no better time of year than the Christmas season to indulge in that sense of enchantment.

There have been many times in our history when our sense of innocence and magic have been challenged. In World War II England, amidst the bombings of London many children were evacuated to the English countryside for their own safety. In *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*, Peter, Susan, Edmund and Lucy Pevensie are set against this historical backdrop as they are sent to live with an eccentric old professor. Thank you for helping shape our world, on stage and off, and bring a lion to life.

I hope that what we have created touches your hearts and imaginations as it has touched all of ours, and now, let us all step through the wardrobe to a world of wonder. But remember where the lamppost is so it can guide us safely home.


